

USER TERMS

1. General

The terms of this User Terms (hereinafter referred to as "User Terms") apply to this web site (www.swedbank.fi of Swedbank AB (publ), Finnish Branch with its principal place of business located at Mannerheimintie 14 B, 00100 Helsinki, Finland and registered in the Finnish Companies Registration Office's registry under number 1973378-1 (hereinafter "Swedbank").

By accessing the Swedbank web site and or using the information and services provided on or via this web site you agree to be bound by this User Terms. In the event of any conflict between the terms and conditions of specific products and services and this User Terms, the conditions specific to such products and services shall prevail.

8. Cookies

The Swedbank web site contains cookies. A cookie is a small text file which is stored on your hard disk by the web site you visit. The text file contains information and is, among other things, used for supporting the visitor's use of the relevant website.
